The following Articulation Agreements are based on the agreements from the 2025-2026 school year and are subject to change.

2. Greater Johnstown Career and Technology Center
3. Construction Technology Program
 - a. GJCTC Dual Enrollment Program
 - i. GJCTC's Electrical Technology or HVAC Program (7.65 credits and/or 80 clock hours, a tuition savings of \$1,178.)
 - ii. GJCTC's Mobile Equipment Operations (7.65 credits and/or 80 clock hours, a tuition savings of \$1,620.)
 - iii. To qualify for the GJCTC Dual Enrollment Program, students must have completed the NCCER Core Curriculum prior to high school graduation.
4. Penn Highlands Community College
 - a. All GJCTC Secondary Program
 - i. Entrepreneurship A.A.S – up to 15 Credits
 - b. GJCTC Culinary Arts Program
 - i. Culinary Arts A.A.S – up to 11 Credits
 - c. GJCTC Graphic and Digital Media Design
 - i. Marketing A.A.S. – up to 3 Credits
 - d. GJCTC Health Assistant Program
 - i. Medical Assisting Technology – up to 6 Credits
 - e. GJCTC Pre-Teacher Preparation Program
 - i. Education A.A. Elementary Track – up to 9 Credits
 - ii. Dual Enrollment Program is available through PHCC, up to 9 Credits
5. Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology
 - a. GJCTC Collision Repair and Industrial Refinishing
 - i. 12 Credits toward TSCT Collision Repair Technology
 - b. GJCTC Machine Tool Technology
 - i. 11 Credits toward TSCT Computer-Integrated Machining
 - c. GJCTC Welding Program
 - i. 10 Credits toward TSCT Welding Technology
 - ii. 9 Credits toward TSCT Advanced Welding & Fabrication Technology



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6. St. Francis University

- a. All GJCTC accredited secondary programs of study must be completed successfully and mastered on the secondary level. Each course of study of at least 720 clock hours and listed below will be accepted as the equivalent of six (6) credits into an associate degree program and twelve (12) credits into a bachelor's degree program at Saint Francis University.
 - i. CTC credits are transferable as listed below, for each associate degree program offered through Division of Professional Studies
 1. Associate of Business Administration
 - a. BUS 101 Wall Street: Business in a Global Society
 - b. BUS Elective
 2. Associate of Early Childhood Education*
 - a. EDUC250 Family, Community Relations in ECE
 - b. EDUC231 Child Growth and Development

*An evaluation of the CTC, EGE program will need to be completed to confirm that PDE competencies are being met.
 - ii. CTC credits earned for a specialized certificate at GJCTC are transferable for up to 48 credits for the Associate of Applied Science, Specialized Studies program offered through the Division of Professional Studies.
 - iii. CTC credits are transferable as twelve (12) credits of free electives into any of the Bachelor of Art or Bachelor of Science programs.



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
