### »»» WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

You can take college-level courses taught by your high school teachers to earn college credit in various general education subjects while still in high school.

Advisors will help you explore how courses can be used toward completing a Penn Highlands degree program or help determine how courses may support a four-year degree at another institution.

### »»» HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Courses offered in the high school are \$69 per credit hour (*subject to change*), which is a reduced tuition rate. Most courses are three credits; however, some may have additional credit requirements. A maximum of 21 credits can be taken.

### »»» THINK BEYOND HIGH SCHOOL!

The ACE Bridge Scholarship financially supports and assists dual enrollment students in their pursuit of obtaining an associate degree or certificate. Students can be awarded up to \$500 per semester at Penn Highlands after high school.
